



## Prepare the scanner for pairing

- 1 Turn on the scanner by holding down the trigger for 3 seconds.
- 2 Scan the following barcodes to prepare the scanner for an Android device.

	2.1 Enter Setup - The indicator becomes purple
	2.2 Factory Reset - The indicator becomes red
	2.3 Enter Setup
	2.4 One-Click Android Keyboard Connection
	2.5 Exit & Save



## Pair the scanner with your Android device

- 3 Restart the scanner by holding down the trigger for 6 seconds, then power back on.
- 4 Enable Bluetooth on the Android device and connect to CT10, pass code is 10010.
- 5 Once successfully paired the scanner will beep

## Configure the scanner for use with Frontier Mobile

- 6 Scan the following barcodes to configure for use with the Frontier Mobile App

	6.1 Enter Setup
	6.2 Do Not Apply Enter for Suffix
	6.3 Apply Settings
	6.4 Exit & Save



## Important notes

When Bluetooth is enabled, the scanner takes over the keyboard function of the Android device. With Bluetooth on, it is not possible to enter your PIN number. We suggest you start the App, enter your PIN, enable Bluetooth and start using the scanner. Alternatively, you can print out your PIN code in a barcode format, then scan the PIN barcode to sign into the App.
